

About our cabins

Cabins 3, 4, 5 and 6 have a sleeping loft (third bed). All cabins also have complete kitchens with dishes, utensils, pots & pans, full-size refrigerator, electric range/oven, coffee pot, toaster and microwave.

All cabins are heated with natural gas, have two private bedrooms, TV, cable and wi-fi, sofa sleeper, and a bathroom with shower.

There is a coin laundry on the premises for guests.

Guests are to furnish their own linens (full-size beds), towels, and all paper products, as maid service is unavailable during occupancy. Linen and towels are available upon request during our fall/winter season.

Pets are allowed after Labor Day until Memorial with prior approval at a cost of \$20 per night, per pet with a 2 pet minimum per cabin.

A deposit of \$150 for weekly rental is required within 7 days of initial contact to guarantee reservation. Off season rental deposit will vary according to rental time and number of people. Refund of deposit requires cancellation by May 1st, replacement booking, less a \$50 service charge. Deposits for multiple or group cabin reservations are non-refundable.

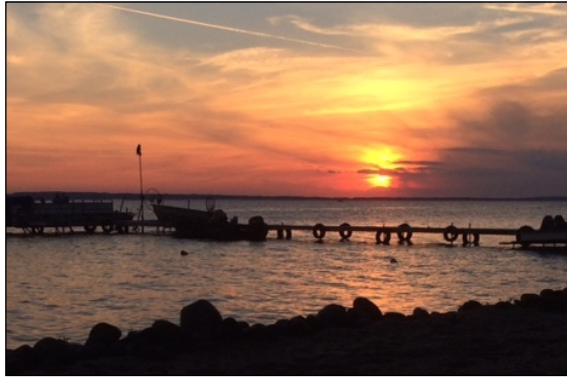

Fishing boats: Enjoy Houghton Lake's terrific walleye, pike, perch, bass and pan fish angling. Aluminum 14-foot fishing boats are available at no charge for our guests. Life preservers, oars and anchors are also provided. Motors can be rented on an hourly, daily or weekly basis.

Pontoon boats: Relax and enjoy Michigan's largest inland lake on one of Foughts Resort's pontoon boats, available for daily and weekly rental. It is best to reserve a pontoon boat when you make your cabin reservation, as demand for pontoon boats are high.

Paddle boats: Two paddle boats are available at no charge for our guests.
